Analysis Report of Students' Feedback

Session: 2021-22

Students are important stake holders and their feedback plays a significant role in the revision of the curriculum. Feedback from students about their experience in higher education was a rarity. Kaliachak college conducts feedback process for knowing perspective of the students and their thoughtful and constructive feedback is used to make improvements in order to enhance their growth and development if needed. The overall average score of students' feedback of Kaliachak College is 3.48.

Following is the analysis of the opinion provided by the students:

- All of the students (100%) were strongly agreeing with the question about “students are informed about Program Outcomes and Course Outcomes for each course” (Score 4).
- All of the students (100%) were agreeing with the question about “teaching plan for curriculum implementation is available to students” by students (Score 3).
- 100% of the students were strongly agreeing with the question about “the institute arranges internship, student exchange, field visit opportunities for students” (Score 4).
- 75% of the students were strongly agree and 25% were agree with the question about “the curriculum is student centric, and based on experiential learning, participative learning and problem solving for enhancing learning experiences” (Score 3.75).
- 50% students were strongly agreeing and 50% were agreeing with the question about “the curriculum is helpful in skill development and employability” (Score 3.5).
- 100% students were strongly agreeing with the question about “the syllabus can be completed within the stipulated time” (Score 3).
- 50% students were strongly agreeing and 50% were agreeing with the question about “the course/programme offers sufficient number of choices” (Score 3.5).
- 25% students were strongly agreeing and 75% were agreeing with the question about “sufficient number of prescribed books/study materials are available in the library” (Score 3.25).
- 50% students were strongly agreeing and 50% were agreeing with the question about “the curriculum is in tune with the state/national level examinations in the relevant subject” (Score 3.5).
- 25% students were strongly agreeing and 75% were agreeing with the question about “the internal evaluation system as it exists in the college is effective” (Score 3.25).
